**Seasonal Camper Permit Guidelines & Request Form 2020 (rules/fees subject to change for future years)**

Sleepy Hollow values our seasonal campers and enjoys having all of our seasonal campers on site. Below are the guidelines needed for your benefit to ensure a pleasant, enjoyable, and safe stay at Sleepy Hollow for everyone.

- The application is not a guarantee of a seasonal offer. The seasonal offers will be communicated to you by February 15<sup>th</sup> of the new season.
- Beginning of season will be when sites are available based on when we turn on the water to the park; weather permitting this should be the first Saturday of April. Feel free to move into your site then. End of season will be when water is turned off around November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- The yard space for your site will need to be mowed &/or weeded routinely. If this does not occur, management will give notice then we will weed for the seasonal camper for an additional charge on the final bill. We will mow the common open areas only in the middle of the week.
- Do not dig holes/ditches, do not cut any trees, and do not attach any item to trees or poles.
- Storage units are limited to one per campsite & the size & location of such unit must be approved by management. The size limit is 6 feet x 6 feet & type is a vinyl shed: kits available at most stores.
- All clothes lines **MUST** be taken down when not in use for safety for everyone.
- All decks must be approved by management **PRIOR** to building the semi-permanent structure. When a camper vacates a camp site any deck or structure left after move date is property of the park and not to be moved.
- Please do not move the fire ring without management permission. Any custom fire rings build need management approval. Please extinguish all fires before you retire.
- Please pick up all trash at your site. Please keep sites clean & dispose of trash properly.
- Utilize the dump station for 100% of your needs. **Do NOT let gray or black water run onto the ground, this is enforced by DNR & in our climate the gray water can pool & can smell just as bad as black water Also, we do not want contaminations in our water well.** The particles of food will attract insects/animal life also. Management will fine campers for infractions.

- **No tents are to be erected on your camp site or any common open areas. If a tent is needed, it will be erected in the tent area only and will be booked like any reservation, based on availability.**
- Only your immediate family is allowed at your site for overnight stays. **Immediate Family is defined as dependent unmarried children under the age of 21 that live at home can be at the camper.**
- Visitor passes are available for your guest on a daily bases, nightly bases or per the season for a discount rate.
- Limit to 1 vehicle per site. Some sites might hold 2 vehicles. Please utilize visitor parking.
- Parking passes will be required on all vehicles at the park. The park will not give more than 3 vehicle passes per seasonal site. Please share your passes or purchase an additional pass. A replacement fee will apply for a lost vehicle pass.
- Wristbands for all individuals in the pool, swimming beach, fishing or activities will be required. Each site will get 4, more only for immediate family members as defined above. Additional bands can be purchased as needed. All to be turned in each season at the end of September. If lost a fee will apply.
- All children must be supervised at all times. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children in all locations of the park.
- All pets will be controlled by a leash. Pick up after your pet. Pets are to be supervised at all times & keep barking to a minimum. No pets in the pool, beach, swim area or public buildings/areas.
- The golf cart will require a rule review, copy of proof of golf cart insurance and registration fee for season before the golf cart can be on the premise. The age of the driver of the golf cart must follow your insurance rules, since you are responsible. The park requires drivers to be at least age 14 with a valid permit or license to drive. We will not allow drivers under this age except if an adult age 18 or older is next to the driver. No other motorized vehicle will be allowed to include gators/side by sides, ATV's, dirt bikes, or go-carts, electric or gas powered. All golf carts and drivers must follow the golf cart rules.
- Quiet time is 10:00 PM- 08:00 AM.
- All campsites are non-transferable by you to any other person.
- Speed limit is 10 MPH at all times. Please limit driving to the roads, no driving on the grassy areas/yards.
- Be considerate and respectful of your neighbors. This will include not walking or driving through their yard, talk to your neighbors when issues arise in a polite way, keep noise to a tolerable level, etc.
- No fireworks, any types of explosives or firearms are allowed. (Campers with a permit for a concealed gun will inform management.)
- Do not wash cars at the camp site. Keep washing your camper to minimum – 1-2 times a year only.
- No parking on roads, empty campsites, tent site areas or open grassy areas – extra parking areas is marked on the maps located in the park.

- An email address and current phone numbers is required to be kept on file.
- For all seasonal campers a credit card is required to be kept on file unless fee paid in full prior to due date.
- Fees for returning seasonal campers for the 2020 season (April 1<sup>st</sup>-November 1<sup>st</sup>) are:
  - 30 amp Water/electric sites \$1400 with a \$50.00 discount if paid in full prior to **March 1<sup>st</sup>**.
  - 50 amp Water/electric sites \$1450 with a \$50.00 discount if paid in full prior to **March 1<sup>st</sup>**.
  - 30 amp Full Hook up sites \$1700 with a \$50.00 discount if paid in full prior to **March 1<sup>st</sup>**.
  - 50 amp Full Hook up sites \$1750 with a \$50.00 discount if paid in full prior to **March 1<sup>st</sup>**.
  - If fee paid in 3 equal payments then payments are due on **March 1<sup>st</sup>, April 1<sup>st</sup> & May 1<sup>st</sup>**.
  - A late fee of \$50.00 will be assessed for any late payment each month.
  - A returned check fee is \$50.00.
  - All seasonal fees are non-refundable if you leave prior to the end of the season.
  - The utility fee will be billed at the end of the season. If you wish not to have a large bill after November 1<sup>st</sup>, then you are welcomed to pay a deposit toward the bill by check.
  - Internet access is no charge.
  - Campers/structures (like deck or sheds) left will be assessed a minimal winter storage fee of \$100.00 (\$20.00 a month).
- Management has to right to limit the number of people at each campsite, change the guidelines as needed, evict permitted campers for infractions as deemed necessary by management, may charge a fee for infractions as deemed necessary by management or not continue a seasonal camping permit for lack of payment.
- Seasonal camper permit is designed for weekend use and only up to 2 weeks (10 extra days) full time during the season to stay at the campsite. If Seasonal campers are present more, the camper will be viewed as a monthly permitted camper and will be charged the monthly rate.
  - Text or email AlidaLee when you will be using your extra time.
- Pool and beach areas have posted signs to follow. Below are some but not all of the rules to follow.
  - No lifeguard on duty for pool or beach area so visitors in the water area do so at their own risk.
  - Follow posted rules for beach area and pool.
  - Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older while in the pool or beach area.
  - No child under age 18 is allowed past the swim rope area without an adult age 18 or older present.
  - Floats, kayaks, paddle boards are allowed on the water BUT no child under age 18 allowed without an adult age 18 or older accompanying them.
  - Wristbands are required for pool and beach area for all – swimmers and watchers alike.
  - No alcohol or food allowed in the pool, pool deck area, beach or lake.
  - Pool closed at 10:00pm and beach area closed when the sun goes down due to no lights in area.
- Entrance into the park constitutes permission for management of Sleepy Hollow RV Park and Campground in Oxford, Iowa to photograph visitors' likeness or property while on-premises and to use any resulting pictures or videos for any lawful purposes without compensation to the visitor.
- The visitor assumes all risks and danger incidental to the activity of camping in an outdoor environment including (but not limited to), the danger of being injured by insects/animals, swimming, any game or playground equipment, structured activities/crafts sponsored by the park, any "Act of God"(see below) and not hold the park, the park owners, the park employees liable for injuries or property damages resulting from such causes. (Act of God or natural occurrence shall mean a natural occurrence such as an earthquake, flood, lightning strike, tornado, hurricane, storm, tree limbs fall or similar equally serious act or event which has a major cataclysmic impact or effect.)
- Violation of any rule or state law is grounds for dismissal from the park without refund.
- This property is privately owned and we reserve the right to refuse service to anyone as deemed necessary.
- Any issues throughout the season with a camper could affect approval for the next season. Any unpaid fees/bills could affect approval for next season camping permit.
- At your own risk, trailers/structure (like deck or sheds) may be left on site for the winter. No personal items are to be stored near or under the camper.
